

## **Coronavirus (COVID-19) Infection Prevention & Control Policy for Rainbow Cat Face Painting**

All of us have been affected by the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. I have missed being able to offer you the face painting services that I know you love, and I am looking forward to seeing you again as soon as possible.

My priority is to keep us as safe as possible, and prior to re-opening I have implemented a number of changes which I would like to make you aware of. I have completed the Coronavirus (COVID-19) Infection Prevention and Control course which is accredited by the Guild of Professional Beauty Therapists Ltd, the UK trade body for the makeup industry. I have since made a number of changes in the way that I operate that you will notice when you next see me.

### **Cancellations due to COVID**

#### ***If I feel ill or have symptoms of COVID-19***

I will self-isolate immediately and notify you as soon as possible. This may mean that I have to cancel your appointment at short notice. I appreciate that this may be disappointing but it is done for everyone's safety. If I do have to cancel your booking, you will be able to re-book again, or ask for a deposit refund.

#### ***If you or any of the people you live with feel ill or display any symptoms of COVID-19***

Please advise me as soon as possible as I'm afraid I will not be able to attend your event. I have amended my booking terms and conditions and you will not be charged for bookings that you have to cancel due to self-isolation or COVID-restrictions.

### **Ways of working**

I will wear a clean face mask and visor during face painting. The client can wear a face mask if they wish, but they are not required to do so.

If a client has any open wounds on the face, or appears to be unwell, then I won't be able to paint them.

I will ask each client to sanitise their hands before sitting in the chair and hand sanitiser will be available. I will also sanitise my hands between every client.

I will wipe down any common surfaces between each client, eg. chair arms.

All equipment (eg. brushes) will be disinfected or sterilised in line with the specific manufacturers' instructions for your safety. Water for cleaning brushes will be changed regularly.

Laundering of towels, uniform and sponges is a priority and I can assure you that all laundry is washed at 60 degrees.
